

## *Principal's Notes:*


Dear parents and friends,

Welcome back after our time at home with remote learning and restrictions. There are still many restrictions that we are still facing but hopefully it means that we can get back to what is our new normal lives as soon as possible. I want to congratulate all the students, families and staff for their efforts in remote learning. It is not always easy with technology issues and being away from friends and families. All the students really tried their very best to complete all their tasks as shown from their returned books and folders. The teachers were very happy and excited to have our students back to school and ready to get back into their learning.

Applications have now closed and we will be holding interviews shortly to fill the classroom vacancy for the Year 5 & 6 teacher. Thank you Mrs McNaughton for the tutoring work. Thank you to Mrs Bell for all her fantastic work with year 5 & 6 students and she will be returning to her tutoring role and teaching art.

On Tuesday morning, Miss Purnell completed some online training on Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) Readiness Test. All Victorian Schools are currently being rolled out in stages to start completing their NAPLAN tests online rather than paper based. These tests will allow the school to start getting devices and internet capabilities ready for next years tests. All year 3s and 5s will complete a mixture of test questions, which includes questions similar to the reading, language conventions and numeracy tests that they have already completed earlier this year. The Year 5s will complete their writing task online as well. This is a test on our technology rather than an academic test and an opportunity to practise for future tests.

We held a successful meeting with our architect today and our plans are now finalised for the stadium refurbishment tender process. James, our architect will now finish putting the plans together in readiness to go out for tender. This process will take a few months, as then the tender is open for a four week period. Cavendish is very fortunate to have so many parents willing to give up their own work time to help with this process. A very big thankyou to Karl Price, Michael Todd, Tim Huf and Paul Coates for their assistance and time.


Basketball Victoria has advised us at this stage, Hooptime looks like it will be cancelled. When we receive definite confirmation, we will refund all monies paid.


### **School Mission Statement:**






